

Rules for Interpreting and Applying the Ecclesiastical Calendar

- #1 In Ceremonies of the Catholic Liberal Rite (1964 ed.) by +Irving Cooper, it is permitted, but not required, that the number of Candles displayed on the Altar during the week may be reduced from those used on a Feast/Festival Day, intervening Sundays, and the Octave Day. This is purely a matter of preference for each Parish. The Calendar attached has sought to highlight this rule when applicable as follows: where the column headed "Candles" indicates "All*", "Many*", or "Extra*" for a given day, this is understood to mean that the specified number of candles may be used on the altar, but fewer are permitted. This Ecclesiastical Calendar should not be read as permitting a deviation from the instructions laid out by +Cooper. - #2 The Class of a Sunday (or Feast or Festival) – e.g., A, B, C, or D – should not be confused with the number of candles to be displayed on the altar, though there is a loose association. The Class refers to the priority of the celebration. For example, should two Ecclesiastical days fall on the same civil calendar date, the Class A day should be celebrated instead of the Class B (and so forth). If there are equal Classes, it becomes the Celebrant's choice as to which day is celebrated, in consultation with the Rector, Ordinary, etc.
- #3 For purposes of this Calendar, a **Festival** is a Celebration that extends over a period of days, generally ranging from seven to ten days. (An Octave of Eight Days is the most common.) A **Feast** is a Celebration on a single day. All Sundays are highlighted under the "Day" column by a grey background.
- #4 Some Feast Days occur during the week, between Sundays. At the discretion of the Rector or Ordinary, those Feasts may be recognized.
